

## RV MAINTENANCE

## Keep Your RV Adventure-Ready with Our Maintenance Checklist

PRE-TRIP OR MONTHLY
<ul> <li>Check Battery levels and charging both from shore power and secondary alternator.</li> <li>Check smoke detectors and carbon Monoxide detectors and batteries.</li> <li>Check tire pressure.</li> <li>Check under van and engine compartment for rodents.</li> <li>Clean and wipe down interior and exterior of van. Focus on tires, exhaust tips, stainless panels, awning fabric, and solar panels.</li> <li>Drive your van. Prevents unwanted wear on tires, allows you to check all systems, including charging.</li> <li>Check for firmware/software updates − Batteries, Garmin, Victron inverter.</li> <li>Visually check for any leaks from the ceiling area.</li> <li>Clean out tanks. Fresh, Grey, and Black.</li> <li>Lube toilet ball valve and seals.</li> </ul>
Follow Mercedes' scheduled maintenance for the chassis.
SEMI-ANNUAL / SEASONAL
Deep Cleaning/waxing of exterior. Check Timberline fluid level and fittings Deep cleaning and sanitizing of holding tanks and macerator. Inspect and clean filter screen on the fresh water tank outlet. Weigh your RV loaded and unloaded. Lube/Grease all exterior storage locks. Lube/clean all drawer latches. Inspect all under coach wiring to ensure they're secure. Inspect the secondary alternator belt. Extended and retract awining for condition and opperations. Visually check for any leaks from under van. Clean out sink trap undersink and sanitize.  Follow Mercedes' scheduled maintenance for the chassis.
<b>YEARLY</b>
<ul> <li>All appliances serviced, including fridge, A/C, Timberline.</li> <li>Check all exterior seals and gaskets. A/C, Fantastic Fan, Bathroom vents.</li> <li>Check all sealants on roof around solar panels, awning brackets, and antennas.</li> </ul>
Follow Mercedes' scheduled maintenance for the chassis.
STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS
<ul> <li>Charge batteries to 100% State of Charge, and turn off. If greater than 1 month, store at 50-80% SOT.</li> <li>Winterize your van if freezing temperatrues are a potential.</li> <li>Make sure your awning is in the retracted/closed position.</li> </ul>
