



## RV MAINTENANCE

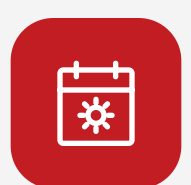
### Keep Your RV Adventure-Ready with Our Maintenance Checklist



#### PRE-TRIP OR MONTHLY

- ☐ Check Battery levels and charging both from shore power and secondary alternator.
- ☐ Check smoke detectors and carbon Monoxide detectors and batteries.
- ☐ Check tire pressure.
- ☐ Check under van and engine compartment for rodents.
- ☐ Clean and wipe down interior and exterior of van. Focus on tires, exhaust tips, stainless panels, awning fabric, and solar panels.
- ☐ Drive your van. Prevents unwanted wear on tires, allows you to check all systems, including charging.
- ☐ Check for firmware/software updates – Batteries, Garmin, Victron inverter.
- ☐ Visually check for any leaks from the ceiling area.
- ☐ Clean out tanks. Fresh, Grey, and Black.
- ☐ Lube toilet ball valve and seals.

**Follow Mercedes' scheduled maintenance for the chassis.**



#### SEMI-ANNUAL / SEASONAL

- ☐ Deep Cleaning/waxing of exterior.
- ☐ Check Timberline fluid level and fittings
- ☐ Deep cleaning and sanitizing of holding tanks and macerator.
- ☐ Inspect and clean filter screen on the fresh water tank outlet.
- ☐ Weigh your RV loaded and unloaded.
- ☐ Lube/Grease all exterior storage locks.
- ☐ Lube/clean all drawer latches.
- ☐ Inspect all under coach wiring to ensure they're secure.
- ☐ Inspect the secondary alternator belt.
- ☐ Extend and retract awning for condition and operations.
- ☐ Visually check for any leaks from under van.
- ☐ Clean out sink trap undersink and sanitize.

**Follow Mercedes' scheduled maintenance for the chassis.**



#### YEARLY

- ☐ All appliances serviced, including fridge, A/C, Timberline.
- ☐ Check all exterior seals and gaskets. A/C, Fantastic Fan, Bathroom vents.
- ☐ Check all sealants on roof around solar panels, awning brackets, and antennas.

**Follow Mercedes' scheduled maintenance for the chassis.**



#### STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

- ☐ Charge batteries to 100% State of Charge, and turn off. If greater than 1 month, store at 50-80% SOT.
- ☐ Winterize your van if freezing temperatures are a potential.
- ☐ Make sure your awning is in the retracted/closed position.
